Staff Council

It serves as an important advisory body to the Principal, assisting with academic and administrative issues as well as the upkeep of all college activities.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell

The main responsibility of the IQAC is to create a system for the deliberate, sustained, and catalytic improvement of the college's overall performance.

Admission Committee

The Admission Committee manages the promotion of college activities in and around Sullurpet to increase college admissions and additionally keeps track of the online admissions procedure for the institute's various UG programmes. The applicants are examined by the members, who then confirm the requirements for eligibility and assign seats based on merit.

Academic Committee

The Committee provides advice to the teaching staff regarding academic issues and the updating of academic records. Additionally, it aids students in comprehending course requirements and departmental academic records in order to gauge their progress.

CPDC

The College Development and Planning Council commits to ensuring proper planning and integrated development at the institution. The CPDC members are in charge of monitoring the college's overall upkeep, maintenance, and assurance of the quality of its academic and administrative constituents.

Games and Sports Committee

Games and Sports Committee trains students in a variety of games and sports and gets them ready to compete in events at the institutional, collegiate, national, and state levels. The committee members accompany the participants to different institutions and States and offer assistance, direction, and inspiration. It looks after the money designated for athletic events and games.

Library Committee

The committee assists the convener in assigning accession numbers to the books received and keeps track of their receipt.

Examination Committee

Both internal midterm exams and university exams are administered by the committee. It keeps track of the internal and external grades of the students enrolled in different courses. The committee also assists the students with university-related issues.

Discipline Committee

The upkeep of discipline on campus is the responsibility of the Disciplinary Committee. It teaches the students how to conduct themselves appropriately, dress appropriately, and speak politely. It educates students about the various legal provisions that prohibit ragging and ensures a ragging-free environment.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell

In order to raise awareness of various career options, the Committee invites experts from various sectors to provide career guidance. Additionally, it informs students about competitive exams by disseminating notifications via social media. The students have access to a variety of skill-focused online and offline certificate programmes. Campus Recruitment Drives are held by the Career Guidance Cell and JKC to offer students placement opportunities

Women Empowerment Cell

The Women Empowerment Cell (WEC) plans events to inform staff and students about gender-related issues and to provide them with information on health, hygiene, the issues with Eve-teasing, the value of learning self-defence techniques, and crucial hotlines in case of an emergency, among other things. The Committee organises various contests to raise awareness of this issue and also plans recurring health camps.

NSS Committee

It incites the volunteers to engage in selfless service and to be sympathetic. It is based on the idea that a person's welfare is determined by the welfare of society as a whole. The NSS Unit has adopted the nearby villages and regularly visits and participates in a variety of activities there.

Eco Club

The Eco Club's primary objective is to safeguard the environment by increasing public awareness of environmental problems. It sponsors numerous events, recognises Environmental Days, educates students about the importance of plantations, and promotes an environmentally conscious attitude in cooperation with the neighborhood forest department. It plans numerous planting campaigns and educational talks about our duty to the environment.

Consumer Club

In order to raise public awareness of consumers' rights, the Consumer Club observes National Consumer Day, organizes programmes, and hosts Extension lectures. Grievance and Redressal committee It is responsible to resolve all types of grievances of the students and staff, looking into the grievances received from both faculty and students and resolving them.

RUSA Committee

The Committee maintains a record of the money that RUSA provided for the construction of college infrastructure. It creates and carries out RUSA plans and gathers and submits financial estimates.

Bio-Metric Committee

This Committee enrols students in the Integrated Attendance Management System that the Government of Andhra Pradesh has launched by collecting the necessary data from them. The information is updated after the students' iris and fingerprints are scanned. The Committee also develops different sections for the College IAMS App and works with the faculty to help add students to their specific sections.

Anti-Ragging Committee

Association of Alumni
